Custom edit and design your own presentation. Under the Pages panel [>Window >Pages] add new pages/slides to add content. Think of your presentation as visual storytelling. Show your process work, variations or micro assignments, [any research], Self-Directed Critique with three categories [List: 2 strengths, 4 weaknesses / Write: 3 paragraphs of self critique / Rate: your work with the rubric categories using 1 to 5. Five is Stellar. One is Draft Quality. Three is Average.
